




# 2°C Stabilization (All Sectors) Mitigation Options at National Level



- ➤ Dialogue held in the context of the East Asia Summit (EAS)
- Shaping international framework (reducing uncertainty, e.g. REDD+)
- Coping with rapid urbanization and motorization
- Appropriate utilization of market mechanism
