Resolution No.24-NQ/TW	To 2020 (Base year: 2005)	Reduce GHG emission/GDP: 8-10%
	2011-2020 (Base year: 2010)	Reduce GHG emission intensity: 8-10% Energy consumption: reduce 20%-30% in comparison with BAU
National Green Growth Strategy	To 2030 (Base year 2010)	Reduce GHG emission at least 1.5-2%/year; Energy consumption: reduce 20-30% in comparison with BAU

Preparation process of INDC

- Policy formulation process
 - Inter-ministerial management
 - International partnership
 - Technical working group
- Technical process.
 - Identify and analyze existing information in Viet Nam
 - Carry out analysis to identify and prioritize mitigation actions: energy, agriculture, LULUCF and waste sectors.
 - Carry out analysis to identify and prioritize adaptation actions: agriculture, water resources and coastal zone management.
 - Develop initial iNDC report
- Consultation process.

What is the public opinion to the target?

Others

- Viet Nam is starting to prepare iNDC report.
- Department of Meteorology Hydrology and Climate Change (DMHCC), Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment (MONRE) is the national focal point in preparing iNDC with the cooperation with MPI, MOF, MOIT, MARD, MOT, MOC.
- National Steering Committee for the UNFCCC and KP is responsible for conducting iNDC development.
- At present, UNDP, GIZ are supporting Viet Nam in preparing iNDC report.
- Implementation:
 - Collect data and information; research and analysis by each sectors.
 - Consultation Workshops, reports.
 - Develop iNDCs report of Viet Nam.
 - Report to National Steering Committee on Climate Change: March 2015.
 - Submit to the UNFCCC: May 2015.
