



Cambodia's Position for COP-21

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I. GHG EMISSIONS IN CAMBODIA

GHG emissions (SNC):

- 1994, a net sink and offset approximately 5,142 Gg. of CO₂ eq.
- 2000, a net emitter, total national net emissions of 220 Gg. of CO₂ eq.
- Main emissions sector: AFOLU
- Per capita emissions 0.31tCO₂ in 2000
- Based on the SNC, no emissions reduction target was set
- CDM is prioritized for GHG emissions reduction

II. GOVERNMENT'S POSITION

- Annex 1 parties should determine their political commitments and leadership to increase the level of GHG mitigation;
- Support the Doha Amendment of the Kyoto Protocol in filling the pre-2020 emission reduction commitment gaps;
- Set a proper carbon pricing so that REDD Plus can be economically competitive;
- Support the provision of new, additional and predictable finance from public sources by Annex I Parties;

- Need more commitment from Annex I Parties to increase their financial contributions to the Green Climate Fund
- Annex I Parties should provide further financial supports to meet the target of US\$100 billion annually by 2020; and
- The 2015 agreement should compose of Measurement, Reporting and Verification (MRV) of financing, meeting costs of adaptation, development and transfer of technology, and capacity building provided by Annex I Parties.
